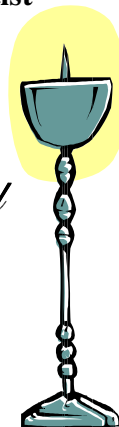

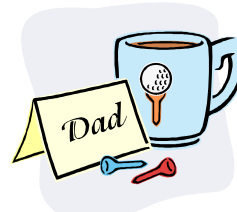
Baseball Game Postponed
