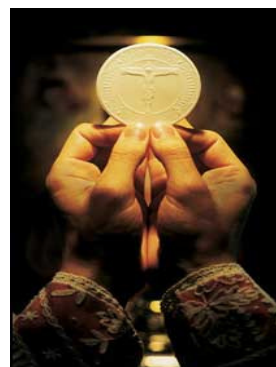
### Catholic Sun
