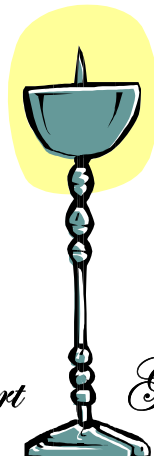

Educational Video

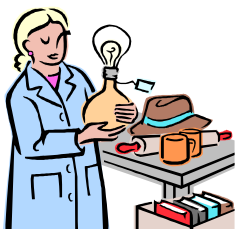
On Wednesday, September 23rd the Center will be showing the educational video "You Don't Need Another Stroke" at 11:00 AM.

Child Church takes place during the 10:30 Mass. Children are welcome.

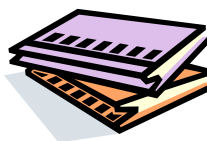
Journey of Faith 2009
